Through our collaborative funds, we create opportunities for donors to learn from the field and direct resources to innovative leaders, organizations, and movements pursuing transformational change:



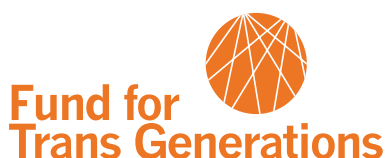
The **Black-Led Movement Fund** supports the Movement for Black Lives (M4BL) so that it can better shape policy agendas for Black communities, create alternatives to institutions that have been harmful to Black people, and build local Black community power. The Fund provides a dedicated vehicle for funders to support the M4BL ecosystem.



The **Communities Transforming Policing Fund** resources local communities impacted by deadly and discriminatory policing practices to build power, increase police accountability and transparency, and redefine safety by advocating for investment in community-based programs and services as alternatives to police, jails, and prisons.



The **Disability Inclusion Fund** supports U.S. groups run by and for disabled people to lead transformational change. The Fund is supported by the Presidents' Council on Disability Inclusion, which committed \$10 million over the next five years to support disability inclusion as part of improving diversity, equity, and inclusion within philanthropy.



The **Fund for Trans Generations** invests in trans-led organizing to support a future where transgender, gender non-conforming, and nonbinary people live with freedom, safety, and self-determination.



Immigration Litigation Fund

The **Immigration Litigation Fund** supports impact litigation to ensure that the nation's immigration enforcement system is fair, humane, and prioritizes the civil and human rights of those vulnerable to deportation or exclusion.

Racial Equity to Accelerate Change Fund



The **Racial Equity to Accelerate Change Fund** is expanding the capacity of racial equity consultants to work with nonprofit organizations. The Fund invests in practitioners to develop and scale tools and strategies for the benefit of the nonprofit sector.



Racial Equity in Journalism Fund

The **Racial Equity in Journalism Fund** invests in news organizations led by and for people of color. The Fund bolsters a strong, diverse, and independent media sector that increases civic engagement for communities of color by reaching them with vital, relevant information.



Racial Equity in Philanthropy Fund

The **Racial Equity in Philanthropy Fund** invests in philanthropy-serving organizations to inform, educate, and equip funders to integrate racial equity policies and practices into their grantmaking and programs. The Fund seeks to normalize grantmaking strategies that prioritize structural change, with the ultimate aim of ending racial disparities.



Spark Justice Fund

The **Spark Justice Fund** resources grassroots organizing groups that are ending money bail and unjust pretrial detention policies. Grantees' longer term goals are to significantly reduce jail populations, decriminalize poverty, and reduce disparities for low-income communities of color, including for women of color and other marginalized people.



Transforming Movements Fund

The **Transforming Movements Fund** supports the bridging role that young LGBTQ leaders play to support movements in becoming more connected, inclusive, and thus more powerful. The Fund invests in organizations and organizers who understand that the issues like community safety, reproductive justice, immigrant rights, and others do not exist in isolation from each other, and who carry out organizing that addresses how these issues intersect.
